## **OLCC Commissioners grant four new licenses, issue 16 sanctions and cancel one license**

**PORTLAND, Ore.** - At their monthly meeting June 18-19, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission granted the following liquor licenses:

**Crooked River Dinner Train**, 495 NE O'Neil Way, Redmond; change of ownership for Full On-Premises, Public Passenger Carrier license. License was granted with restrictions. Licensee is Cougar Canyon Catering, LLC and Jimmy Brundage, Managing Member and Madit Enterprises, LLC and Mike Ditullio, Managing Member.

**Primetime Bar & Grill**, 16015 SE Stark St., Portland; change of ownership for Full On-Premises, Commercial license. License was granted with restrictions. Licensee is RAZ Entertainment Inc.

**JOQ's**, 2512 NE Broadway, Portland, license renewal for Full On-Premises Commercial license. License was granted with restrictions. Licensee is Jerry O. Quaring.

Licensee will also be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee will receive a letter of reprimand. Licensee is Big Smoke, LLC, Hal Baird, Bruce Baird and Shannon Baird, members.

**7-Eleven Store #2363-23071B**, 7800 SE Lake Road, Milwaukie; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Luong Nguyen.

**EZ Stop Grocery & Deli**, 111 N. Front St., Woodburn; will pay a civil penalty of \$1,815 or serve an 11-day suspension. Licensee is Mohammed Jaber.

The following licensees were sanctioned based on a stipulated settlement for permitting an employee(s) to sell, mix, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

**Another Round**, 2155 NE Division Street, Gresham; will pay a \$3,795 civil penalty or serve a 23-day suspension. Licensee is D&M Hospitality, Inc., David Shepherd, Corporate Principal.

**Skyway Bar & Grill**, 71545 E. Hwy 26, Zigzag; will pay a civil penalty of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Faubion Corporation, Thomas Baker and Tracie Anderson, Corporate Principals.

**Jameson's**, 115 W. Broadway, Eugene; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Jameson's, Inc., James Carroll, Corporate Principal.

**Bay 13 Restaurant**, 701 NW 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Portland; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Moana Portland, LLC, Timothy Harmon, member.

**Mary's Club & El Grillo**, 129 SW Broadway, Portland; will pay a civil penalty of \$3,795 or serve a 23-day suspension. Licensees are Mary's Fine Foods, Inc., Vicki Keller, Corporate Principal and Trafican Enterprise, LLC, Dan Trafican, member.

The following businesses will receive sanctions based on a stipulated settlement agreement:

**Bora Bora**, 12431 SE Division St., Portland; will pay a civil penalty of \$4,620 or serve a 28-day suspension for permitting unlawful activity when private security professionals provided security services without being certified to do so which is a violation of ORS 181.991(1)(b) and for permitting noisy activity in areas adjacent to or outside the licensed premises. Licensees are Phillip Sanchez and Mary Pinedo.

**Don Camaron Grill Bar & Nightclub**, 1111 E. Powell Blvd., Gresham; will pay a civil penalty of \$1,155 or serve a seven-day license suspension for allowing a minor in an area prohibited to minors. Licensee is Hermanas Acosta Corporation, Maria Acosta Quintero and Maria R. Acosta, Corporate Principals.

The liquor license for **Dr. Feelgood's Pub**, 13727 SW Pacific Hwy, Tigard; will be cancelled as the result of a history of serious and persistent problems including physical altercations involving fighting, punching, kicking, threats of guns and verbal assaults. Customers, employees and police officers have sustained injuries as a result of 17 documented incidents in 13 months. Licensees are Donald Harvey and Rachel Harvey.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Room 103A in Portland. Subsequent months, the meetings are held via phone.
