Check local liquor store for Holiday hours

PORTLAND, Ore. – The Oregon Liquor Control Commission reminds customers that liquor stores in Oregon have the option to be open on Christmas Day, Dec. 25 and New Year's Day, Jan. 1.

"Liquor agents have the option to spend the holidays with family and friends if they wish," says Merle Lindsey, OLCC Deputy Director of Distilled Spirits.

State law provides that liquor agents have the discretion to open or close on Sundays and holidays. Christmas and New Year's Day are two of the nine state holidays defined by state law.
