OLCC Commissioners approve liquor licenses and issue sanctions for liquor law violations

PORTLAND, Ore. – At its monthly meeting on August 27, 2015, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission approved the following new liquor license applications with restrictions:

Area 52 Bar & Grill, 6920 SE 52nd, Portland; Licensee is Area 52, LLC; Janice Koch-Lumpkin, member.

Rosewood/Cloak & Dagger, 1030 W. Burnside Street, Portland; Licensee is Urban Nightlife, LLC; Mark Byrum, member.

Sensei Sushi Bar & Grill, 710 SW 2nd Ave., Portland; Licensee is Sensei Sushi Bar & Grill, LLC; Ken Chen and Peng Yun Chen, members.

El Rancho Market, 2615 Lancaster Dr. NE, Salem; Licensee is El Rancho Market, LLC; Elsa Ramos-Ramirez and Carlos Armas-Molina, members.

The Commissioners ratified the following fines and liquor license suspensions based on stipulated settlement:

Jay's Bar & Grill, 11595 SE 82nd, Happy Valley; has paid a fine of \$3,795 for permitting a customer to drink alcohol in the parking lot. Licensee is Jay's Bar & Grill, Inc.; Lap Law, Lai Lam, Julia Law, Jenny Law, and Jason Law, corporate principals.

The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him or her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he or she reasonably appeared to be under 26 years of age:

B Lucky Bistro, 528 Harlow Road, Suite A, Springfield; has paid a fine of \$3,795. Licensee is Bistro Group, Ltd.; Richard Hickram, corporate principal.

Red Apple Marketplace, 555 SW 4th, Ontario; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Robb Enterprises, Inc.; Larry Robb and Kimmie Robb, corporate principals.

Denny's #6753, 76 Goodfellow, Ontario; has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensee will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Mountain Range Restaurants, LLC; William Cox and Robert Gentz, members.

Danielle Taste Veneta, 88330 Territorial, Veneta; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Danielle Taste Veneta, LLC, Danielle Cilia, member.

Thomsen's Market, 3444 Main Street, Springfield; has paid a fine of \$1,815. Licensee will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensees are Linda Thomsen and Steven Thomsen.

Licensee will also install age verification equipment and will use the equipment to verify the age of every person purchasing alcohol who appears under 26 years old. The Commissioners ratified the following stipulated settlements for permitting employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages, or supervise those who do, without a valid alcohol service permit.

First National Tap House, 51 W. Broadway, Eugene; has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensee is First National Tap House, LLC; MW1, LLC, member.

The Lifeline Taphouse, 249 NW 6th Street #1 & 3, Redmond; will pay a fine of \$1,155 or serve a seven-day liquor license suspension. Licensee is Life's Ventures, LLC; Christopher Griffin, member.

Ninkasi Brewing Company, 272 Van Buren Street, Eugene; has paid a fine of \$1,485. Licensees are Ninkasi Brewery, LLC, Ninkasi Distribution, LLC, and Ninkasi Tasting Room, LLC; Ninkasi Holding Company, member.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions regarding the regulation of the sale and service of alcoholic beverages in Oregon by administering the state's Liquor Control Act and the regulation of the sale of recreational marijuana in Oregon through the Control, Regulation, and Taxation of Marijuana and Industrial Hemp Act.
