BOARD ACTION REPORT
September 15, 2015

The information contained in this report summarizes new, interim, and final actions taken by the Oregon Medical Board between August 16, 2015, and September 15, 2015.

***Lewis, Sue Ann, MD; MD19554; West Linn, OR**

On August 20, 2015, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily cease the prescribing of all scheduled controlled substances for chronic pain pending the completion of the Board's investigation into her ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

***Miller, Blythe Megan, LAc; AC169738; Portland, OR**

On September 3, 2015, the Board issued an Order Terminating Consent Agreement. This Order terminates Licensee's April 13, 2015, Consent Agreement.

***Thomashefsky, Allen Jan, MD; MD08126; Ashland, OR**

On August 18, 2015, Licensee entered into an Amended Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily cease performing injections other than immunizations and cease retrieving or processing blood and tissue from patients, and to cease using scheduled medications parenterally prior to an office visit, pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine. This Order replaces the Interim Stipulated Order of April 14, 2015.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Sue Ann Lewis, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon and holds an active medical license.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to certain terms until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the Board's concern, Licensee and the Board agree to the entry of this Interim Stipulated Order, which is not an admission of any wrongdoing on the part of the Licensee, and will remain in effect while this matter remains under investigation, and provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions:

3.1 Ninety (90) days from the date Licensee signs this Order, Licensee must stop treating chronic pain patients with any DEA scheduled medications. For the purposes of this Order, chronic pain is defined as pain that persists or progresses over a period of time greater than 30 days.
