BOARD ACTION REPORT
March 15, 2016

The information contained in this report summarizes new, interim, and final actions taken by the Oregon Medical Board between February 16, 2016, and March 15, 2016.

These orders are marked with an * asterisk. **Scanned copies of Consent Agreements are not posted, as they are not disciplinary action and impose no practice limitations.** Complaint and Notices of Proposed Disciplinary Action are not listed in this report, as they are not final actions by the Board. ***Hamilton, Anthony McCrea, PA; PA01072; Klamath Falls, OR**

On February 26, 2016, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily withdraw from practice and place his license in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

Katancik, Cynthia Ann, PA; PA165502; West Linn, OR

On March 3, 2016, the Board issued an Order Terminating Consent Agreement. This Order terminates Licensee's November 5, 2014, Consent Agreement.

***Redfern, Craig Calvin, DO; DO14108; Portland, OR**

On February 19, 2016, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily cease the prescribing of all scheduled controlled substances within 60 days pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

***Russell, Jill Rene, DO; DO17341; Hillsboro, OR**

On March 15, 2016, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily limit her prescribing of controlled substances for chronic pain pending the completion of the Board's investigation into her ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

Schwanke-Khilji, Sara Urana, MD; MD172124; Portland, OR

On March 11, 2016, the Board issued an Order Terminating Consent Agreement. This Order terminates Licensee's April 28, 2015, Consent Agreement.

Shirai, Kumiko, LAc; AC01219; Portland, OR

On March 2, 2016, Licensee entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to complete a 20-hour mentorship with a Board-approved clinical supervisor.

On March 11, 2016, the Board issued an Order Terminating Consent Agreement. This Order terminates Licensee's March 2, 2016, Consent Agreement.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an expeditious manner. Following that review, if the Board determines that Licensee shall not be permitted to return to the practice of medicine, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.

This Order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.265(1) and (2) for the purpose of protecting the public, and making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice medicine. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document and is reportable to the national Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

2 3.3 Sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Order, Licensee must cease
3 prescribing all controlled substances.

4 3.4 Licensee must facilitate the transfer of care and medical records for any patient
5 leaving his practice.

6 3.5 Sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Order, Licensee must surrender his
7 DEA registration.

8 3.6 Licensee understands that violating any term of this Order will be grounds for
9 disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

10 3.7 Licensee understands this Order becomes effective the date he signs it.

11 4.

12 At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, the Board will decide whether to close the
13 case or to proceed to some form of disciplinary action. If the Board determines, following that
14 review, not to lift the requirements of this Order, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that
15 decision.

16 5.

17 This order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.410, which grants the Board the
18 authority to attach conditions to the license of Licensee to practice medicine. These conditions
19 will remain in effect while the Board conducts a complete investigation in order to fully inform
20 itself with respect to the conduct of Licensee. Pursuant to ORS 676.175, Board investigative
21 materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible

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1 as evidence in any judicial proceeding. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document
2 and is reportable to the National Databank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including osteopathic physicians, in the state of Oregon. Jill Rene Russell, DO (Licensee) is a licensed osteopathic physician in the state of Oregon and holds an active medical license.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to certain terms until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the Board's concerns, Licensee and the Board agree to the entry of this Interim Stipulated Order, which is not an admission of any wrongdoing on the part of the Licensee, and will remain in effect while this matter remains under investigation, and provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions:

3.1 From the date that Licensee signs this Order, Licensee must not begin treatment for chronic pain with controlled substances for any new or existing patient, and must not increase the dosage or add controlled substances for any existing chronic pain patient. For the purposes of this Order, chronic pain is defined as pain that persists or progresses over a period of time greater than 30 days.
