#### Need for the Rule(s):

Clean needle technique standards are nationally recognized, evidence-based best practices for acupuncture needle safety. The Clean Needle Technique Manual is published by the Council of Colleges of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine in consultation with OSHA and the CDC.

A rulemaking hearing will be held to gather additional input from the community to determine the impact on Oregon-licensed acupuncturists.

Acupuncture Needles

- (1) A licensed acupuncturist must follow clean needle technique standards.
- (2) Needles inserted to stimulate specific points on the surface of the body must be

disposable, single use, filiform acupuncture needles.
