Approved Minutes

Subcommittee members in attendance: Tim Custer, Wade Bryant, Jeff Frieze, Steve Doane, Pat Harris, Forest Bohall, and Vicki Ramming

Staff present: Ian Caldwell, Mike Law, Ron Price, Pamela Berger, and Jeff Trejo

February 10, 2015

Chair Custer called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m.

Ron: Introduction of new committee Law Enforcement Representative, Sergeant Jeff Frieze.

Ron: Introduction of new OPRD ATV Safety Education Coordinator, Jeff Trejo.

Chair Custer: We still need a dealer representative on the full committee.

Ron: The Oregon Attorney General issued an opinion on the taxability of volunteer's mileage. Volunteers will no longer receive a 1099.

Wade, Tim, and Pat agreed to extend their membership terms for an additional four years. Ron will process the necessary paperwork.

Trejo: No charge for meeting room use at the fairgrounds until 2016.

The next ATV meeting is scheduled for April 1 & 2, 2015 holding the grant meeting in Winchester Bay, followed by site visits in the afternoon.

Other topics discussed: Dunefest, Prospect signing area and Riley Ranch. The dune access in the Saunders area which is 15 acres that received ATV grant funds with the South Coast Trail Riders. Agreement states the land must provide dunes access. The west half is for dune riding. During the past three years clearing and building has occurred. Possible building plans.

Public Comment: Ethan Lodwig, Emerald Trail Riders Association in Eugene, thanked committee members for their hard work. He noted that multiple user groups are willing to help out with ATV legislation.

Election of subcommittee Vice Chair:

Currently Pat is chair of ATV full committee, Tim is the vice-chair of ATV subcommittee, Tim is the chair of subcommittee and Rod Roberts was the vice-chair of subcommittee, which is the position that needs to be filled.

MOTION: Vicki moved to elect Wade as the Vice-Chair of the ATV subcommittee. Steve seconded the motion. There being no objections, the motion passed unanimously.

Discussed ATV related legislative concept for 2015.

There are several proposed bills, which would allow ATVs use of paved streets if approved by land manager. Change definition of Class I and IV vehicles to focus more on width instead of seat/steering wheel, and license plate.

Funding Allocation Discussion:

We have about \$8 million for grants and currently requests are over 9 million.

Jeff Frieze: Discussed coverage of law enforcement in various areas. Different functions for different type of law enforcement. Some areas have double and triple coverage.

Tim: We've talked about this before to determine if there is any coordination. The former Grants Manager, Wayne Rawlins, received some information from the Oregon State Police. He noted that Ron is now tracking those statistics. Tim received an email from a Bend resident who stated he was stopped by three different agencies in the same riding area.

Jeff Frieze: Talked about county and FPO patrols during increased dune use such as Dunefest and holidays. Some folks were cited for federal court, while others received diversion. It's confusing for all.

Tim: During the 15-17 grant cycle we should explore different options for funding law enforcement patrols.

Frank Letore, Randy Peterson, and Clyde Zeller, ODF gave a PowerPoint presentation regarding the automatic transfer of O&M funds to be used in the Clatsop and Tillamook State Forests. They gave a summary of this year's fiscal report.

Wade: Suggests giving a reminder card when an ATV sticker is purchased to prompt riders to obtain online training.

Chair Custer recessed the meeting at 5:15 p.m.

Wednesday, February 11, 2015

Chair Custer reconvened the meeting at 7:45 a.m.

Ian: Noted that the 2015 Law Enforcement workshop has been cancelled. Staff is planning one for the spring of 2016.

Mike provided a list of equipment purchased with ATV grants, which he will expand to include mileage use.

Motion: Wade moved to adopt the April 15, 2014 minutes. Steve seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Motion:

Wade moved to adopt the March 10, 2014 minutes. Steve seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Members asked if last biennium's McCoy project included funding to stripe the roads (no) and if they received an RTP grant for restrooms (yes). Custer asked if there is any reason we couldn't fund striping. Ian said that if the road is used for ATV access then we can pay our fair share.

Chair Custer: Called the meeting to order at 7:45 a.m.

MOTION: Vicki moved to table the Pilot Rock equipment purchase grant to be resubmitted at the April meeting. PAT seconded.

Discussion on Motion: Ian explained that the land was donated to the club, which began in 2007 by the city. They are not using city trucks or equipment for the OHV track. Jeff Frieze thinks that storage should be provided for equipment and vehicles. Wade feels changes in the equipment can be made to make better use the funds.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Vicki moved to withdraw the above motion to table the Pilot Rock grant. Pat seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Members discussed concerns about striping and fencing for private land for the McCoy project.

Vicki: They are using ATV funds for areas that are also used by hikers and snowmobiles.

Applegate should increase their project funding to 9,000 - 10,000 to allow room to make needed purchases.

MOTION: Vicki moved to increase the funding to \$10,000 to purchase additional similar safety equipment. Wade seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Jeff Frieze: Noted that line item 42 for BLM Medford requests law enforcement for areas already funded by timber patrols. Ian: They are asking for funds that cover the ATV portion of patrols. Wade: There is little activity June – August. Discussion on number of crashes. County sheriffs are contracted out. Ian: Usually we have the sheriff's office submit the grant, not the BLM. Vicki: They may be supplementing. Mike: Line item 41 EIA plan hasn't been completed. Ron: We're putting the cart before the horse. The funding is going towards staff and some materials.

Members voiced their concerns of paying for MRA's executive director position. Forest will talk to Jack.

MOTION: Wade moved to remove the funding of the executive director position in grant #1860 if it scores within criteria. Steve seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Steve moved to table grant #1783 until the April meeting if it scores within the criteria. Pat seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Steve moved to withdraw the above motion to grant #1783 until April. Pat seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

After members ranked all the LE & OM grants presented at this week's meeting. Their determination was that all grants receiving a score of 70 or over be recommend for funding.

All others are tabled until the April meeting. No representation will be requested at that meeting. Applicants will have the opportunity to revise their budget sheet in the meantime; however they are not required to make changes.

Ron: 8.07 million is available to fund all grants including O&M and LE grants.

Scoring criteria is different from LE than O&M

O&M 5.8 million

Forest recuses himself for MRA

Ian: Need to reduce grants overall by 1 million

Vicki: Suggested asking applicants not to exceed last biennium's request.

Morrow County would be asked to reduce engine in addition to other cuts.

MOTION: Vicki moved to recommend funding for all O&M grants that received 70 points and above Wade seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Vicki moved to recommend to table all O&M that received under 70 points until the April meeting asking applicants to resubmit their budget. Wade seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Vicki moved to recommend funding all Law Enforcement grants that received 70 points and above Forest seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Vicki moved to recommend to table all Law Enforcement grants that received under 70 points until the April meeting asking applicants to resubmit their budget. Forest seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Wade moved that all grants that were tabled for the LE and O&M to let the existing scores stand except the discretionary points. Pat seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Target date for applicants to re-submit budget and grant: February 25, 2015
Planning, safety education, development and emergency medical grants will also be heard at this meeting.

Chair Custer adjourns the meeting at 5:09 p.m.
