## Important Competitors Information

- Open to novice and intermediate competitors.
- **Not** an ALA Sanctioned Event.

## Agreements and Waivers

- You will be required to sign a condition of agreement and waiver when you sign in on the day of the competition.
- Competitors under the age of 18 will need the signature of a parent or legal guardian to participate and should pre-sign and return the waiver to the park prior to the competition. The parent or guardian also must be present at the event.

## Schedule

- Sign-up and Set-up begins at 8:30 a.m.
- Sizing must be completed by 10 a.m.
- Competitors' Meeting at 10 a.m.
- Competition Opening at 11 a.m.
- Events competition begins at 11:20 a.m.

## Equipment

- Collier State Park provides all nails and screws.
- Only factory peg and raker saws permitted in sawing events.
- Sawing and chopping wood is ponderosa pine.
- Each competitor must supply their own tools and safety gear. The following safety gear is required to compete:
  - Hard Hat / Helmet
  - Gloves
  - Chain Mail / Toe and Shin Guards
  - Safety Glasses
- If you are sharing equipment, please indicate in the "special notes" section your registration.
- Only competitors and event volunteers are allowed in the contestant and event areas. Family and friends are welcome but must remain in the public areas.

## Events Information

- Events as follows:
  - Men's and Women's Double-Buck
  - Men's and Women's Horizontal Chop
  - The Axe Throw
  - Men's and Women's Choker Race
  - Birling
- Each event is limited to 16 competitors as follows:

- Events with a "Men's/Women's" Category will have a limit of 8 competitors per category. A waiting list will be kept for cancelations and filled as they occur. If either category does not reach limit those spaces will open to the waiting list after registration closes.
- The Axe Throw will have a limit of 16 competitors.
- The Double Buck will take eight teams, four per category. A waiting list will be kept for cancelations. If either category does not reach limit by the closing date, those spaces will open to the waiting list after the event registration closes.
- Each competitor in a double-buck team is required to register for the event and sign-in the day of the competition.

**Prizes**

- Prizes will be presented at the end of the event. Double-buck teams split award monies and will be responsible for distributing the award appropriately.

**Cancelations**

- A waiting list will be maintained for additional applicants in the case of cancellations or open slots. Cancelations to filled categories will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis as they occur. Open spots in event categories will be after registration closes on June 5th and will be on a first-come first-serve basis.
