Need for the rule(s): The current rules restrict the awards to memorials on land owned by regional or local governments, while the statute also provides awards for monuments on state, federal, tribal and other publicly owned land. The current rule requires the Local Government Grand Program Advisory Committee rather than a committee with focused expertise on monuments, military history, etc..
