

Amends rules governing non-traditional use of state parks and ocean shores; adds a "definitions" section to the rule; clarifies when a special-use permit is required; updates criteria that are used to evaluate applications; updates requirements placed on applicants; clarifies application procedure; aligns fees with legislatively approved fee structure.
