

Stewart Award History

L. L. "Stub" Stewart served for 30 years as a charter member of the former State Park Advisory Committee, before co-founding and sitting on the Oregon Parks and Recreation Commission. Stub was the first recipient of the award, and in 1992 he endowed this program so others would receive recognition for their contribution to Oregon Parks and Recreation Department. Stub's dedication and exceptional service set a standard for this award. The spirit of volunteerism that Stub so admirably exemplified during his lifetime continues on in so many ways today.

Rising Star Award

Exceptional volunteer service over a short period of time (no longer than three years). The individual has shown great promise as a "star of tomorrow." Their recent service has positively benefited the activities of the association and increased the group's capacity to provide interpretive services.

Inspiration Award

The volunteer inspires others to join in, to give greater effort or to become actively involved in the association. Leadership skills of the individual have made a significant impact on other volunteers within the group.

Leadership Award

The staff member leads by example, committed to support the shared goals of the park and the cooperative association. Supports the mutual relationship and helps support the friends' activities and programs.

Life Service Award

Exceptional volunteer service over an extended period of time. Individuals have made a significant impact on overall program and/or development of the association and have helped to increase the capacity of the group to provide interpretive and educational programs and activities.


