Facts:

The NCEES defines general education credits as 16 credit hours in subjects such as a philosophy, religion, history, literature, fine arts, sociology, psychology, political science, anthropology, micro and macroeconomics, ethics and social responsibility.

Analysis: The Board determined to approve individuals who are deficient by 8 or fewer of the 16 general education credits required by NCEES as substantially equivalent to a degree. If the applicant is deficient by more than 8 general education credits, the EQC will review their application further.

Action: Staff will review applications accordingly.
