BARD Mobile: The 3-Step Process

The BARD Mobile app for iOS and Android devices has generated a lot of excitement, and an increasing number of people are eager to sign up. For students and individuals wanting to get started, here is a 3-step checklist to make sure the process is as quick and smooth as possible.

Step 1: Register with Talking Books

Anyone who is interested in using the BARD Mobile app must first be a registered user of Talking Books. Qualified individuals can find applications on the Registration page at www.ORTalkingBooks.org. You can submit a completed application by mail, by fax, or by scan/email.

Step 2: Sign up for BARD

Before you can start using the BARD Mobile app, you need to create a BARD account. There is a link on our homepage to the BARD online application. Once your application has been approved you will receive a temporary password via email. Use this temporary password to log into BARD and finalize your account by creating a permanent password.

Step 3: Download the BARD Mobile app

Once you have a BARD user name (email address) and permanent password, you can download the BARD Mobile app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store. Search for the words "BARD Mobile" and find the app authored by the Library of Congress. Open the app, login, and you'll be all set.
