

Facebook and Twitter Promotional Drawings

Privacy Statement

To register and participate in this promotion, and other Oregon State Police, Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) promotions, you must provide some personal information such as your name, mailing address, email address and/or telephone number so that the OSFM can contact you. We collect no personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. If you win a prize, we may use your photograph, first name and the city where you live in an OSFM promotional campaign, advertisement, or press release. You should be aware that although we do not generally disclose personal information to others, all information collected at the OSFM Facebook and Twitter sites become a public record under Oregon's Public Records Law, ORS 192.410 to 192.505 and may be subject to inspection and copying by the public. We will be required to disclose your personal information if ordered by a court or the Attorney General, or if otherwise required by law.

Terms and Conditions

I. OVERVIEW

These Terms and Conditions are to ensure that the winner selection process is conducted in accordance with procedures and rules to assure the complete integrity, fairness, honesty, and security of the winner selection process. No purchase or payment is necessary to win.

Facebook – How to Enter

- 1) "Like" the OSFM on Facebook via www.facebook.com/OregonStateFireMarshal.
- 2) Comment on the post for the specific Facebook Promotional Drawing. See the OSFM's Facebook timeline for more details.
 - For TestitTuesday, include a photo entry ("Selfie" photo featuring smoke alarm testing) with your comment.
 - For TriviaThursday, include the answer to the question.

Once the above two steps are completed, this will be recorded as an entry.

Twitter – How to Enter

- 1) "Follow" the OSFM on Twitter, via @OSFM.
- 2) Reply (@OSFM) to the post for the specific Twitter Promotional Drawing. See the OSFM's Twitter feed for more details.
 - For #TestitTuesday, include a photo entry ("Selfie" photo featuring smoke alarm testing) with your reply. Include #firesafeOregon in your reply.
 - For #TriviaThursday, include the answer to the question in your reply. Include #firesafeOregon in your reply.

Once the above two steps are completed, this will be recorded as an entry.

Multiple Entries per Person

You may not submit multiple entries. Only one entry per person per promotion will be counted. Anyone found to use multiple accounts to enter will be ineligible.

Inappropriate Content

Obscene, provocative, or otherwise questionable content will not be considered and removed from the OSFM Facebook and Twitter pages. The OSFM retains sole discretion as to what constitutes inappropriate content.

Prize

The prize(s) description will be listed in the initial posts on Facebook and Twitter.

Entry Period

The entry period will be listed in the initial post on Facebook and Twitter.

Drawing Date

The date of winner selection is at the OSFM's discretion. However, winner selections will occur within two (2) weeks of entry closure. To save money and resources, the OSFM may secure the entries from multiple Facebook and Twitter Promotions to conduct all winning selections on a single date.

II. PURPOSE

- A. To ensure selected winners are determined as impartially as practical.
- B. To ensure the integrity of the OSFM is maintained.
- C. To ensure winner selection is conducted in strict compliance with Terms and Conditions.
- D. To ensure compliance to all applicable OSFM statutes, rules, and regulations.

III. ELIGIBILITY

- A. You must be an Oregon resident at least eighteen 18 years of age at the time of entry. Employees or representatives of the Oregon State Police, their spouses/domestic partners, children, brothers, sisters, or parents are not eligible to participate.
- B. Facebook: You must "Like" the OSFM on Facebook and comment on the OSFM Facebook Promotional drawing's specific post. For TestitTuesday, include a photo entry with your comment. For TriviaThursday, include the answer to the question.
Twitter: You must "Follow" the OSFM on Twitter, via @OSFM and reply to the post for the specific Twitter Promotional Drawing. For #TestitTuesday, include a photo entry your reply. For #TriviaThursday, include the answer to the question in your reply.
- C. Only one entry per Facebook and Twitter accounts per drawing is allowed.
- D. A prize may have restrictions, such as "must reside in the state of Oregon." If this is the case, the restriction(s) will be listed on the initial post.
- E. The OSFM State Fire Marshal or designee will make all final decisions regarding the eligibility or entries and/or participants.
- F. If the OSFM or other Oregon state agency determined that you stole data from, or were associated with attacking, infecting, or intruding upon, any computer system owned by or associated with the OSFM, or performed any action or conduct which in any way threatens the security of the OSFM's computer system, the OSFM may immediately disqualify any portion of,

or the entire list of entries. The OSFM reserves the right to seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law and may seek criminal charges.

G. If the OSFM determines an entry to be valid, and the entry was not entered into the drawing due to an error by the OSFM or the OSFM database provider, as determined by the OSFM State Fire Marshal or designee, that entry can be entered into a comparable drawing for a prize of like value, or an alternate prize may be offered at a future time to be determined by the OSFM State Fire Marshal or designee. The OSFM State Fire Marshal or designee's decision is final.

H. Entrants in the promotion hereby release, indemnify, and hold harmless Facebook and Twitter, its owners, officers, officials, agents, and or employees, from any and all claims, demands, losses, and liability arising out of, or related in any way to their/my participation in this promotion.

IV. WINNER SELECTION DETAILS

A. The Fire Prevention Month panel will select the TestitTuesday winners. The first person with the correct answer for the TriviaThursday is the winner.

B. Drawing dates, times, and locations may be changed at the discretion of the OSFM State Fire Marshal or designee.

V. NOTIFICATION OF WINNER

A. Winner notifications will happen no later than two (2) weeks following the drawing.

B. The OSFM will contact perspective winners via a Facebook message or Twitter direct message to obtain contact information. Winner(s) will be announced via Facebook and Twitter posts.

C. Winners will have to private message the OSFM through Facebook or Twitter, or contact the OSFM via phone or email at: 503-934-8228 or osfm.ce@state.or.us with their email address or phone number within 72 hours of notification for prize fulfillment.

D. The winner will have seven (7) days from the date of the OSFM sent email notification to claim the prize unless there are different instructions in the initial post.

E. If the winner does not claim the prize, an alternate will be contacted. This process will continue until all the prizes are awarded, there are no more alternates, or the prize claim deadline passes.
