GUEST SPEAKER IS BILL HENLE

Bill recently retired from Portland Fire and Rescue as their Hazardous Materials Coordinator for the past 18 years. He has over 35 years experience in Hazardous Materials and the Fire Service, starting his Fire Career in the Chicago area. Bill has responded to several hundred hazardous material incidents during his career and brings this experience to the classroom.

While working for Portland Fire, he was responsible for all hazardous materials operations and training for the 700 member fire department, where he was also the Team Leader for the full-time Hazmat Response Team. Bill also has five years experience in the private environmental response field where he supervised and managed projects including emergency response to train derailments, tunnel and chemical fires, and tanker accidents. He has also worked in all the Command Staff positions including Incident Commander, Safety Officer, PIO and Liaison Officer.

Bill has provided training for the State of Oregon Regional Hazmat Teams, Washington State Fire Marshal, local Explosive Disposal Units, the FBI, the 102nd Civil Support Team, Hospitals, plus thousands of firefighters, police officers, military, other governmental agencies and private industry across the United States. He provides training in all aspects of hazmat response, clandestine drug labs and most levels of NIMS as well as consulting with the public, private and military sectors. Recently, Bill has provided “real life” full-scale exercises for a variety of entities in the Northwest.

Over the years, Bill has been a Presenter and Lecturer at various hazmat conferences across the U.S. including the International Hazmat Teams Conference, Hazmat Explo, the International Fire Instructors Conference, OFIA Safety Symposium, and the Continuing Challenge along with four years experience as an Adjunct Instructor for the National Fire Academy.
