### **Incident reports and resource inventory forms due January 30**

Fire department incident reports and fire resource inventory forms are due to the Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) by January 30, 2009.

- Incident report data is necessary to determine fire-trend analysis and guide the direction of fire-related programs and activities throughout Oregon. The OSFM also submits these reports to the National Fire Incident Reporting System to ensure Oregon departments qualify for U.S. Fire Administration Assistance to Firefighter grants. - Fire Resource Inventory Report forms have been sent to all Oregon fire chiefs via email or standard mail. Most departments received an email with an attached Excel file.
