





JUVENILES INVOLVED WITH FIRE DEMOGRAPHICS 2009


89%	Male
11%	Female
33%	Ages 9 and under
67%	Ages 10 and above
35%	living in Single Parent Family, Mother only
33%	living with both Biological Parents
11%	living in a Step Family (Birth Parent remarried)
5%	living in Single Parent Family, Father only
4%	living in Foster Family
12%	living in other family type
59%	had no previous firesets
39%	had between 1 and 5 previous firesets
2%	had 6 or more previous firesets

AGES OF JUVENILES INVOLVED WITH FIRE 2007-2009






JUVENILE-SET FIRES BY MONTH OF INCIDENT 2005-2009
