INCIDENT REVIEW

Each team present reported on incidents that had occurred since July.

EQUIPMENT COMMITTEE UPDATE ~ Kyle Romey, HM05 Linn/Benton

The Equipment Committee is starting up again. They will be meeting to evaluate detection equipment specifically for Chlorine and Ammonia. The committee will be evaluating four to five single source detectors as well as the Drager C.M.S. detector as possibilities. The meeting will be scheduled sometime in the next two months. This evaluation should be completed in one meeting, two at the most. The meeting will begin with vendor presentations, then a question and answer period, followed by an opportunity for the committee to test the monitors, and hopefully the committee will be able to close the meeting with a unanimous decision. OSFM and committee chair Kyle Romey hope to see representation from each team at this meeting. Kyle will be sending out an email to each team rep with more information and a meeting date and time.

The following team expressed a need to have their decon showers replaced HM01 Roseburg, HM02 Eugene, HM14 Ontario, HM04 Klamath/Lake, and HM08 SO. Oregon. HM11 Astoria just replaced their decon shower. Mark Truax will send out the website information from the company that they purchased their decon shower from.

Kyle and Mariana meet to review the Level A survey. Based on the survey results the immediate needs for suits are as follows:

- First priority: HM05 (Linn-Benton), HM14 (Ontario),
HM10 (Hermiston) HM12 (LaGrande)
- Second priority: [HM02 (Eugene), HM03 (Gresham),
HM04 (Klamath Falls), HM08 (Medford),
HM09 (TVF&R), HM15 (Coos Bay)]
- Third priority: HM01 (Roseburg), HM06 (Portland),
HM11 (Astoria), HM13 (Salem).

An OEM grant of \$120,000 has been received for purchasing suits, chlorine and ammonia monitors. Seventy-five percent of the suits can be bought now, and OEM may have additional grant funds later for more suits.

OSFM is working with DAS to have a direct purchase contract for suits in place 2010.

MONITOR UPDATE, Mariana Ruiz-Temple, OSFM

The ITX monitors have arrived. OSFM needs to purchase laptops to go with each monitor. If you don't want to wait for the laptops to arrive and would like to pick up your monitor and docking station please contact Bruce Armstrong to make arrangements for pickup. The purchase of the second ITX monitor is currently on hold due to budget forecasting. IF OSFM is only required make the 5-10% budget cut, we should still be able to purchase the second monitor. OSFM should know more by the January meeting.

Grant funds have been received for a drill next year to take place on the coast or in Central Oregon. The drill will take place around this time next year. More information to follow.
