### **Guest Speakers**

#### **GENELL GROW AND BRAND MCCALLISTER – St. Helens Federal Credit Union**

St. Helens Community Federal Credit Union (SHCFUCU), located in Columbia County, Oregon, was originally formed to serve the employees of the St. Helens Pulp and Paper Company and the Jaite Company. It was formed as a member-owned non-profit cooperative to help meet the financial needs of these employees and their families.

Over the years, SHCFUCU has expanded their field of membership to include anyone who lives, works, attends school, volunteers, or worships in Columbia County or Sauvie Island, Oregon. In 1989, the name of the credit union was changed to St. Helens Community Federal Credit Union in order to better reflect its membership base. The Disaster Recovery Plan at SHCFUCU created in 2008, is a collaborative effort and a living document; each department in each of 3 branches, has their own role in its success.



**Brandi McCallister** is a native Clatskanie and the Human Resources Specialist 2 at SHCFUCU where she began working in 2007. Brandi administers payroll, employee benefits, new employee training, Family Medical Leave (FMLA) and disability claims, the staff incentive program, and a host of other duties in her position. Brandi has been a CEPA member since 2008.

**Genell Grow** has worked in Columbia County since 1989 and lived in Rainier/Goble since 2000. Genell is the Senior Vice President of Human Resources & Organizational Development at the Credit Union where she oversees all things HR with a focus on employee relations, talent management, staff development and performance, strategic planning, and legal and safety issues which includes the Credit Union's Disaster Recovery Plan. Genell has also served as a volunteer mediator for Columbia County small claims court since 2005 thanks to a training program sponsored by Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) provided for community leaders and volunteers. Genell has been a CEPA member since 2001.
