Through his career he has commanded various units to include: Homicide, SWAT, White Collar Crime, Family Violence, Child Abuse, Intelligence, Crime Lab, Canine (K-9), School Resource Officer unit, 911-Communications, Lake Patrol and Traffic operations. He also served as the Field Training Director.

He began his career in 1977 serving as a Military Policeman in the US Army, and from 1980 to 1986, was a Patrolman with Baytown, Texas PD.
