**GUEST SPEAKER – JEFF DUKES – UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD**



Jeff Dukes, Manager Hazardous Materials, Union Pacific Railroad

Jeff has been employed by Union Pacific for four years. As a hazmat manager, Jeff's primary mission is responding to railroad hazmat emergencies and environmental incidents. Jeff has a territory that stretches from Klamath Falls to Seattle, and from Portland to Eastport. Jeff provides outreach for fire departments that are within his territory, as well. The outreach ranges from a railroad 101 class for new firefighters, to discussing the valve configurations on tank cars and commodities being shipped with the regional hazmat teams. Another training Jeff provides is a 40 hour railroad tank car specialist course in Pueblo, Colorado. Jeff and his counterparts are instructors for this course that enlists both firefighters and emergency response contractors. This course provides fundamental railroad and tank car information as well as training in damage assessment and mitigation measures.
