Introductions were made.

Minutes from February were approved.

#### **Type 6 Rate:**

The group agreed to use the T6 rate proposed during the February meeting (\$50/hour).

#### **Local Districts & Unprotected Lands:**

The group discussed whether the added language adequately conveyed the essential fact that responding departments may set their own rates when responding outside of their jurisdictions.

#### **Authority Having Jurisdiction:**

The term was added to the glossary because it's used in the Conflagration Request Packet, but the group feels it's important not to confuse the intent. The group agreed to replace the AHJ reference in Appendix D with 'agency providing resources' or something to that effect.

#### **DPSST Certifications:**

The new certifications have been fully adopted by DPSST. The only change is that Firefighter 2 has been added.

#### **PowerPoint Review:**

The group reviewed Greg's PowerPoint presentation. It will be presented for the first time during the annual IMT Training next week in Redmond. A number of changes were suggested by the group.

**Panel Lunch:**

Mariana intends to send an email to all Fire Chiefs seeking questions before the lunch discussion. The panel is almost fully established, though OSFM is still seeking an experienced Task Force Leader. Doug K. will look into folks from the east side to fill the TFL role.

**Overhead Volunteers:**

The group agreed to table this discussion until the 2014 Mob Plan Committee forms. For 2013, overhead volunteers will be paid at \$17/hour.

**Issues Since Last Meeting:**

The only issue brought forth has been that of scheduling. Mariana intends to have a discussion with OFCA about the timing and location of the Fire Defense Board Meeting. Because our meeting is on Monday and the conference doesn't officially begin until Wednesday, some people have expressed concern that their schedules might not allow them to attend.
