Our guest speaker is James Roddey –Earth Sciences Information Officer, Oregon Dept. of Geology and Mineral Industries.

The presentation will focus on the general history of the Cascadia Subduction Zone (CSZ) and what it means for Oregon. He'll talk about:

- *Is there a relationship with the CSZ and the San Andreas Fault?*
- *How does episodic tremor and slip relate to earthquake probabilities on the CSZ?*
- *How are new findings on tsunami inundation in Cannon Beach going to affect the rest of the Oregon Coast?*
- *Most importantly, how hard will the ground shake and what's the probability that this will happen in our lifetime?*



"The Department of Geology's "Prophet of Doom" will answer these questions and more!" James Roddey has been with the Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI) since 1998. He is not a geologist, but he plays one on TV... in other words, when the media calls, he's the guy they talk to...

Since he moved to Oregon we've had the wettest winter on record and the driest year on record... could this mean something?

As Earth Sciences Information Officer, James helps the public understand the sometimes arcane and complex world of geology. From producing publications that let people know about Oregon's rich geologic history to traveling the state talking about earthquakes, tsunamis, landslides and other geologic mischief, James enjoys his role as the Department's "Chicken Little."

Prior to moving to Portland, James lived in Flagstaff, Arizona, where he produced and directed 65 educational earth science TV programs for kids that aired on The Learning Channel from 1995 to 1997. *Geonauts* was produced in partnership with the National Park Service and Grand Canyon National Park was the program's outdoor classroom...

He and his wife Amy hike, canoe, kayak, camp, ski and explore the west with their 10 year old, Sarah, every chance they get.
