Claimant J.R. Simplot, Trustee for the J.R. Simplot Self-Declaration of Revocable  
Trust ("Simplot"), Contestants United States of America (the "United States"), the  
Klamath Tribes, and Klamath Project Water Users (the "KPWU")<sup>1</sup> (collectively,

“Contestants”), and the Oregon Water Resources Department (the “Department”) hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

**A. STIPULATED FACTS**

1. On January 31, 1991, Metropolitan Life Insurance Company dba ZX Land & Cattle Company filed Claim No. 35 in the Klamath Basin Adjudication. Simplot subsequently acquired the property that is the subject of Claim No. 35.

2. On October 4, 1999, the Adjudicator issued his Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 35, preliminarily approving the claim, but for less acreage and a smaller quantity of water than was claimed.

3. On May 8, 2000, the KPWU filed Contest 3384 alleging insufficient evidence for the right claimed and alleging that the required elements are not established for the claim.

4. On May 8, 2000, Simplot filed Contest 2765 to Claim 35 contesting the Adjudicator’s Preliminary Evaluation with respect to the Adjudicator’s disapproval of ZX Creek as a source.

5. On May 8, 2000, the United States filed Contest 3783 alleging insufficient evidence to establish the elements of the water right claimed and contesting the acreage and diversion rate. On May 5, 2003, the United States filed an Amended Statement of Contest of Claim and Preliminary Evaluation of Claim alleging that natural overflow is not a valid water right.

6. On May 8, 2000, the Klamath Tribes filed Contest 4091 alleging insufficient evidence to establish the elements of the water right claimed and contesting the acreage and

diversion rate. On May 5, 2003, the Klamath Tribes filed an Amended Statement of Contest of Claim and Preliminary Evaluation of Claim alleging that natural overflow is not a valid water right.

7. On August 29, 2003, Administrative Law Judge Maurice J. Russell signed the Stipulation to Resolve Contests 2765 and 3384 and Order Thereon. KPWU and Simplot agreed that their respective contests were resolved without need for hearing pursuant to the terms of the August 29, 2003 Stipulation and Order. Simplot and KPWU agree that the terms outlined below are consistent with the August 29, 2003 Stipulation and Order, and Contests 2765 and 3384 can be resolved without need for hearing.

8. Simplot, the United States and the Klamath Tribes agree that Contests 3783 and 4091 can be resolved without need for hearing pursuant to the terms outlined below.

**B. TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT**

1. Simplot, the United States, the Klamath Tribes, the KPWU, and the Department agree that the terms of the water right derived from Claim No. 35 in this Adjudication are as follows:

- a. POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATIONS:  
SW ¼ NE ¼, Section 21, Township 32S, R14E, W.M.  
SW ¼ SE ¼, Section 21, Township 32S, R14E, W.M.
- b. SOURCE: Sycan River, tributary to Sprague River
- c. USE: Irrigation of 170.0 acres and stock
- d. AMOUNT BENEFICIALLY USED: 4.25 cubic feet per second (cfs), measured at the point of diversion and further limited to a diversion not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
- e. PERIOD OF USE: March 1 to October 31 for irrigation; April 1 to October 31 for stock

- f. PRIORITY DATE: October 8, 1879
- g. PLACE OF USE:
  - NW ¼ NE ¼ 32.0 acres irrigation and livestock
  - SW ¼ NE ¼ 7.0 acres irrigation and livestock
  - NE ¼ NW ¼ 32.5 acres irrigation and livestock
  - NW ¼ NW ¼ 31.0 acres irrigation and livestock
  - SW ¼ NW ¼ 36.5 acres irrigation and livestock
  - SE ¼ NW ¼ 18.0 acres irrigation and livestock
  - NW ¼ SW ¼ 12.0 acres irrigation and livestock

2. Contestant United States agrees that, pursuant to this agreement, the United States' Contest 3783 described in Paragraph A.5 has been satisfactorily resolved and such resolution vitiates the need for a hearing on Contest 3783 before the Office of Administrative Hearings.

3. Contestant the Klamath Tribes agrees that, pursuant to this agreement, the Klamath Tribes' Contest 4091 described in Paragraph A.6 has been satisfactorily resolved and such resolution vitiates the need for a hearing on Contest 4091 before the Office of Administrative Hearings.

4. Contestant the KPWU agrees that, pursuant to the August 29, 2003 Stipulation and Order and this agreement, the KPWU's Contest 3384 has been satisfactorily resolved and such resolution vitiates the need for a hearing on Contest 3384 before the Office of Administrative Hearings.

5. Claimant Simplot agrees that, pursuant to the August 29, 2003 Stipulation and Order and this agreement, Simplot's Contest 2765 has been satisfactorily resolved and such resolution vitiates the need for a hearing on Contest 2765 before the Office of Administrative Hearings.

6. The Department staff agree to recommend to the Chief Adjudicator the terms of Claim No. 35 as described in Paragraph B.1.

7. If the Findings of Fact and Final Order of Determination issued by the Adjudicator for Claim No. 35 do not accord with the terms listed in Paragraph B.1 above, Simplot reserves any rights it may have to file exceptions to the Findings of Fact and Final Order of Determination as to Claim No. 35 in the Circuit Court for Klamath County, and reserves any rights Simplot may have to participate in any future proceedings authorized by law.

8. If the Findings of Fact and Final Order of Determination issued by the Adjudicator for Claim No. 35 exceeds the scope and extent of limitations on the claim as set forth in Paragraph B.1 above, the United States, the Klamath Tribes, and the KPWU reserve any rights they may have to file exceptions to the Findings of Fact and Final Order of Determination as to Claim No. 35 in the Circuit Court for Klamath County, and reserve any rights they may have to participate in any future proceedings authorized by law.

9. In exchange for the United States and the Klamath Tribes resolution of Contests 3783 and 4091, Simplot also agrees to withdraw Contests 2766, 2767, 2768, and 2769 of Claim Nos. 663, 665, 667 and 612, respectively, in the Klamath Basin Adjudication Case No. 279 within 30 days of receiving a signed order from the Office of Administrative Hearings on this Stipulation and Order.
