The GENERAL FINDINGS OF FACT of the FINAL ORDER OF DETERMINATION is incorporated as if set forth fully herein.

**A. FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On April 30, 1997, the UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT (BLM) timely submitted a Statement and Proof of Claim (Claim 365) to the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) pursuant to ORS Chapter 539 in the Klamath Basin Adjudication claiming a federal reserved water right under an Executive Order entitled Public Water Resource (PWR) No. 107, authorized by President Coolidge.
2. On August 30, 1999, the BLM timely amended Claim 365 as to point of diversion coordinates.
3. On October 4, 1999, following investigation of the evidence submitted, the Adjudicator issued a Summary and Preliminary Evaluation of Claims (Preliminary Evaluation), stating the claim was approved [as amended].
4. On May 8, 2000, the following parties, hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Klamath Project Water Users", filed Contest 3613: Klamath Irrigation District, Klamath Drainage District, Tulelake Irrigation District, Klamath Basin Improvement District, Ady District Improvement Company, Enterprise Irrigation District, Klamath Hills District Improvement Co., Malin Irrigation District, Midland District Improvement Company, Pine Grove Irrigation District, Pioneer District Improvement Company, Poe Valley Improvement District, Shasta View Irrigation District, Sunnyside Irrigation District, Don

Johnston & Son, Modoc Lumber Co., Bradley S. Luscombe, Berlva Pritchard<sup>1</sup>, Don Vincent<sup>2</sup>, Randy Walthall, Inter-County Title Co., Winema Hunting Lodge, Inc., Van Brimmer Ditch Co., Plevna District Improvement Co., and Collins Products, LLC.

5. These matters were referred to the Office of Administrative Hearings for a contested case hearing. The Office of Administrative Hearings designated these matters and other like claims of the BLM as Case 276.
6. On November 14, 2003, Klamath Project Water Users voluntarily withdrew Contest 3613. *See* NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN CONTESTS (Nov. 14, 2003).
7. On August 2, 2004, the OWRD and BLM executed SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE OREGON WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT AND THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT ON CLAIM NOS. 325-375 (Settlement Agreement) which states the BLM did not contest the Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 365 because “the preliminary evaluations [of claims 346, 365, and 369] accurately describe and approve the claims.
8. On August 2, 2004, the Adjudicator withdrew Case 276 from the Office of Administrative Hearings.

## **B. DETERMINATION**

1. The Settlement Agreement executed between OWRD and BLM is adopted and incorporated as if set forth fully herein, with the exception that gallons per minute have been converted to cubic feet per second and rounded to the nearest thousandth for administrative convenience.
2. The Executive Order entitled PWR No. 107 for a federal reserved water right is a valid basis for this claim. The GENERAL CONCLUSIONS OF LAW CONCERNING CLAIMS BASED ON PUBLIC WATER RESERVE NO. 107 is incorporated as if set forth fully herein.
3. Based on the file and record herein, IT IS ORDERED that Claim 365 is approved as set forth in the following Water Right Claim Description.
