Improving instream flow in

More than one beneficial use for a water right



Split-season leasing:

- Allow more than one use swap per season
- Support necessary monitoring to prevent enlargement/injury
- Would facilitate conservation irrigation and voluntary rotations

Multiple beneficial uses on a water right:

- Already exists (irrigation, domestic, stock)
- Examples in Shasta Basin
- Can be well defined conditions




Broad participation is an essential element for success!
