## PUBLIC NOTICE

### **Seasonally Varying Flows Task Force Meeting to be Held October 10, 2014**

The Seasonally Varying Flows Task Force, established by Senate Bill 839 (2013), will hold its fourth meeting from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM at the Water Resources Department on Friday, October 10. The meeting is open to the public.

The meeting will include presentations on existing water right permitting procedures, as well as continued discussions on Seasonally Varying Flow methodologies proposed in the Science Subgroup report (see more information about the subgroups on our webpage below).

#### **Background**

As called for in SB 839 (2013), the *Seasonally Varying Flows (SVF) Task Force* will develop guidelines to determine which stream flows should be protected when public funds are used to support certain types of water storage projects. The Task Force will prepare and submit its report to the Governor, an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly, and the Water Resources Commission. Subsequently, the Water Resources Commission shall adopt rules to establish a methodology for use in determining the seasonally varying flows. This Task Force is tentatively scheduled to meet on October 10<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>.

Senate Bill 839 also calls for the creation of a *Governance Task Force* to review the structure established for water development project loans and grants in SB 839. The Task Force will develop proposals related to: (a) the role of the state in providing loan and grant funding for multipurpose water resource development; and (b) the decision-making process for the allocation of newly developed water from projects for which the uses of the water were not specified in the funding application. The resulting report will be submitted to the Governor and an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly and may contain recommendations for legislation. The next meeting for this task force is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, October 30<sup>th</sup>.

This work represents a major initiative by Oregon to take a more active role in meeting instream and out-of-stream water needs, recognizing the challenges created by a growing population, drier and warmer seasons, and declining federal involvement.
