10-Year Plan for Facilities

Phase 1 Projects

Updated: June 21, 2016

- 1. Consolidation with Hillcrest Youth Correctional Facility in Salem:** Hillcrest will close in June 2017 and all of its youth, staff, and programs will move to MaLaren. ([FAQ about this project](#))
 - Current status: Planning stage
 - Projected completion: June 2017
- 2. Building new living units:** We are building six new living units on the east end of campus. The units will feature single rooms and will house up to 16 youth in each building.
 - Current status: Under construction
 - Projected completion: Late spring 2017
- 3. Remodeling Grover Cottage:** We are fully renovating this living unit to bring it more in line with our agency's focus on positive human development.
 - Current status: Under construction
 - Projected completion: Late summer 2016
- 4. Improving existing living units:** We are making smaller improvements to the other existing cottages, including new paint, flooring and other interior changes.
 - Current status: Under construction
 - Projected completion: June 2017
- 5. Intake and health clinic remodel:** We are remodeling the clinic to create a more secure, yet more normal environment, more like a regular doctor's office. It also will include a new intake area to work with youth when they first arrive at OYA.
 - Current status: Design complete; seeking construction bids
 - Projected completion: Spring 2017
- 6. Updating Thayer Treatment Mall:** This previously-empty building will receive new plumbing, carpet, paint, and other updates to become a new Treatment Mall that provides programming for youth.
 - Current status: Design complete; seeking construction bids
 - Projected completion: Early 2017
- 7. Other upgrades:** We are completing several maintenance- and security-related improvements, including replacing the sewage plant and installing new digital cameras across campus to increase youth safety.
 - Sewage plant improvements: In design; to be completed late fall 2016
 - Security cameras: Ongoing; to be completed June 2017
