



Advisory Committee Vacancy Learn and Serve

Oregon state law provides for a deferred compensation advisory committee for the Oregon Savings Growth Plan (OSGP). The committee has seven members selected by the PERS Board to reflect a cross section of participant groups. The key role of the advisory committee can best be described as participant representation. It also provides information and advice to OSGP and the PERS Board as well as providing a forum for feedback and an opportunity for interaction. This committee typically meets four times per year in Tigard and Salem, and attendance at the meetings is required.

There are currently two vacancies on this seven-member body. One is open to any OSGP participant employed by a state agency, and the other is open to a participant of a local government, community college, or school district that has adopted the plan. To be considered, you must be a participant in OSGP and have an interest in seeing the plan grow and succeed. A financial background is not required.
