**RULE SUMMARY**

These rules are needed to allow pharmacy residents who have been accepted into an accredited program and who have obtained pharmacist licensure in another state. Without this temporary rule, pharmacy residents will not be able to be licensed pharmacists in Oregon and satisfy reciprocity requirements.

**Justification of Temporary Rule(s):**

Without this temporary rule in place, pharmacy residents who have obtained pharmacist licensure in another state will not be able to participate in an Oregon Residency Program until they have first been licensed as a pharmacist for one full year.
