RULE SUMMARY

Oregon Laws 2013, Chapter 340 amends Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 689 and requires the Board of Pharmacy to establish rules for the distribution of unit-of-use naloxone and the necessary medical supplies to administer it in opiate overdose emergency situations. Administration of naloxone may only take place by those who have successfully completed training or who have been identified in OL 2013, Chapter 340.

Without this temporary rule in place, pharmacies, health care professionals with prescriptions and dispensing privileges or any other person designated by the Board of Pharmacy, will not be able to distribute unit-of-use packages of naloxone to individuals who have successfully completed training as described in OL 2013, Chapter 340.

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
