Bonds for Career/Technical Facility Improvement, Security, Safety and Upgrades

Shall TVCC expand/improve the workforce career/technical facility and make other campus upgrades by issuing \$4,800,000 general obligation bonds?

If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution [ORS 250.037(1)].

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

If voters approve this measure and provide funding for the workforce career/technical education (CTE) facility, \$2,830,250 in State matching funds are available to Treasure Valley Community College ("TVCC").

If approved, this measure is expected to:

- Expand and improve the workforce career/technical education (CTE) facility, including purchasing temporary classroom space that would be repurposed by TVCC upon completion of the project.
- Fund site improvements, furnishings, equipment, and other related project costs and bond issuance costs.
- Improve safety and security including required ADA improvements; fund remodeling, deferred maintenance and upgrade projects.

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed 21 years and may be issued in one or more series. The estimated incremental tax rate is approximately \$.16 cents per \$1,000 of assessed property value above next year's levels. Actual rates may differ based upon interest rates incurred and growth in assessed value.
