This matter is before the Board on remand from the Court of Appeals. Pursuant to the court's March 20, 2002 order, we have been directed to consider the parties' proposed settlement. The parties have submitted two proposed "Stipulation and Disputed Claim Settlement Agreement[s]" that are designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them, in lieu of all prior orders.

Specifically, the settlements are intended to resolve disputes pending before the Board on remand, as well as before the Hearings Division (WCB Case No. 01-05823). Regarding the settlement in WCB Case No. 01-05823 regarding claimant's 1960 injury claim, that portion which pertains to the Hearings Division has received Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) approval. Pursuant to that portion of the settlement that pertains to this case, claimant stipulates that the SAIF Corporation's denial, as supplemented in the agreement, "shall remain in full force and effect." Claimant further agrees that the Request for Hearing "shall be dismissed with prejudice."

Regarding the settlement in this case regarding claimant's 1998 injury claim, claimant agrees that SAIF's denial "shall remain in full force and effect." The settlement further provides that this matter "shall be dismissed with prejudice."

We approve that portion of the parties' settlement regarding claimant's 1960 injury claim that pertains to this case and the parties' settlement that pertains to claimant's 1998 injury claim, thereby fully and finally resolving their disputes, in lieu of all prior orders. This matter is dismissed with prejudice.
