The insurer has submitted claimant's request for reopening of his Own Motion claim for a worsened condition. ORS 656.278(1)(a) (2001). Claimant's aggravation rights have expired. The insurer recommends reopening of claimant's 1989 claim.

Based on the record, we are persuaded that claimant meets the criteria necessary for his claim to be reopened for a "worsening" of his accepted conditions ("crush injury with right foot amputation, multiple contusions & pelvic fracture"). ORS 656.278(1)(a) (2001); *James J. Kemp*, 54 Van Natta 491 (2002). Accordingly, we authorize the reopening of the claim for the insurer to process the claim in accordance with law. When claimant is medically stationary, the insurer shall close the claim pursuant to OAR 438-012-0055.¹

IT IS SO ORDERED.
