The SAIF Corporation has submitted two “Carrier’s Own Motion Recommendation” forms, indicating that claimant requests that it reopen his August 1, 1996 and March 28, 1995 injury claims for a “worsening” of his previously accepted right finger conditions. *See* ORS 656.278(1)(a) (2001). SAIF recommends against reopening the claims.

In response, claimant asserted that the “finger claims don’t really matter in the current dispute.” Claimant further requested that the “fingers claims” be “drop[ped].”

Under such circumstances, we interpret claimant’s statements as a withdrawal of his current requests for Own Motion relief under ORS 656.278(1)(a) (2001) regarding the 1996 and 1995 right finger claims. Accordingly, the requests for Own Motion relief are dismissed.
