Claimant requested Own Motion relief, noting that although the SAIF Corporation had issued a July 28, 2004 responsibility denial in his 1996 right shoulder claim, it had not processed the claim under ORS 656.278. Claimant requested a hearing regarding that denial. (WCB Case No. 04-03848).

On August 5, 2004, we deferred Own Motion claim reopening action until pending litigation on related issues had been resolved. We also reminded SAIF of its obligation to submit a written Own Motion recommendation. *See* OAR 438-012-0030.

On July 15, 2005, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Crummé approved a “Stipulation and Order” that resolved the parties’ disputes pending before the Hearings Division and dismissed claimant’s hearing requests. Pursuant to the stipulation, SAIF agreed to reopen claimant’s 2001 injury claim. The parties also stipulated that issues pending before us under claimant’s 1996 Own Motion claim have been resolved.

Accordingly, this Own Motion matter is dismissed.
