The SAIF Corporation has submitted claimant's request for claim reopening for a "worsening" claim for a previously accepted condition ("bilateral carpal tunnel"). *See* ORS 656.278(1)(a) (2001). Claimant's aggravation rights have expired.

On June 11, 1992, the Board previously approved a Claim Disposition Agreement (CDA), in which claimant released all rights to "non-medical service" benefits (including Own Motion benefits under ORS 656.278) under this 1987 claim. Based on our approval of the CDA (which includes the condition "bilateral carpal tunnel syndrome"), this request for Own Motion relief is denied. *See Barbara Bolster*, 55 Van Natta 2466 (2003) (reopening of "worsening" claim under ORS 656.278(1)(a) (2001) denied because prior CDA released all rights to "non-medical service" benefits).
