The SAIF Corporation submitted a “Carrier’s Own Motion Recommendation,” indicating that claimant requests that it reopen his 1984 injury claim for a “worsening” of his previously accepted conditions. *See* ORS 656.278(1)(a). SAIF opposed reopening, contending that claimant’s compensable conditions do not require any medical treatment that qualifies for claim reopening.

In response, claimant states that he is seeking “further medical evaluation and treatment and may again request Own Motion reopening at a latter date.” Consequently, claimant withdraws his “request to reopen his claim at this time.”

Based on claimant’s announcement, this Own Motion matter is dismissed
