On May 17, 2011, we issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that set aside the self-insured employer's denial of claimant's injury/occupational disease claim for a left wrist condition. The employer petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement" (DCS) designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them, in lieu of all prior orders. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve the parties' dispute pending before the Court of Appeals. We are authorized to consider the parties' DCS. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the agreement, claimant understands that the employer's denial, as supplemented in the agreement, "shall remain in full force and effect." The parties further agree that the petition for judicial review "shall be dismissed with prejudice."

We have approved the parties' settlement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
