Claimant, *pro se*, requests review of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Naugle's order that: (1) upheld the SAIF Corporation's denial of claimant's combined low back condition; and (2) upheld SAIF's denials of claimant's new/omitted medical condition claims for thoracic and sacral injuries, cervical strain, C5-6 herniated disc, right C4-5 herniated disc, T10-11 disc bulge, L1-2 disc bulge, end plate fractures, and edema.¹ On review, the issue is compensability.²

We adopt and affirm the ALJ's order.³

ORDER

The ALJ's order dated August 9, 2010 is affirmed.
