On September 8, 2011, we issued an order that reversed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that awarded 8 percent whole person impairment and 20 percent work disability. Claimant petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed agreement designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve the parties' disputes pending before the Court of Appeals and before the Hearings Division (WCB Case Nos. 11-05421, 11-05161). We are authorized to consider those portions of the settlement that concern issues pending before the court. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

An ALJ has approved those portions of the agreement that pertain to the disputes pending before the Hearings Division. Pursuant to those portions of the agreement, claimant agrees to withdraw his pending requests for hearing. Regarding the portion of the agreement involving the issue pending before the court, claimant agrees to withdraw his pending request for review. Finally, the parties stipulate that those requests "shall be dismissed with prejudice."

We have approved that portion of the parties' settlement that pertains to this matter, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute in this case. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
