On June 13, 2012, we issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's order that: (1) declined to award additional temporary disability; and (2) declined to award penalties and attorney fees for allegedly unreasonable claim processing. Claimant petitioned for judicial review. The parties have now submitted a Claim Disposition Agreement (CDA), in which claimant has released all of his "non-medical service related" rights to compensation (including temporary disability and penalties and attorney fees with certain exceptions) related to his April 2011 injury. The agreement also provides that, on its approval, this matter shall be dismissed. We have approved the CDA.

Under such circumstances, the issues pending in this case have been rendered moot. Accordingly, consistent with our authority under ORS 656.298(9)(a), this matter is dismissed.¹
