On July 17, 2012, the Board issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that set aside the self-insured employer's denial of claimant's injury claim for a left shoulder condition. The employer petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement and Stipulations," which is designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them, in lieu of all prior orders in this case, as well as issues pending before the Hearings Division (WCB Case Nos. 12-04889, 12-04291).

Those portions of the parties' agreement that pertain to issues pending before the Hearings Division have received ALJ approval. We are authorized to consider those portions of the settlement that concern the parties' dispute pending before the Court of Appeals. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the agreement, claimant agrees that her claims "shall remain in denied status." The parties further agree that all hearing requests "shall be dismissed with prejudice."

We have approved those portions of the parties' settlement that pertain to this case, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
