Claimant requests review of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Mills's order that upheld the SAIF Corporation's denial of claimant's new/omitted medical condition claim for a left shoulder rotator cuff tear. On review, the issue is compensability.

We adopt and affirm the ALJ's order. *See Michael D. Demagalski*, 45 Van Natta 2251 (1993) (although the claimant's accepted arm condition may have indirectly contributed to his bicycle accident, because his arm was in a cast as a result of treatment for the compensable injury and he was unable to adequately use the hand brake due to the cast, the accepted arm condition was not the major contributing cause of the left wrist fracture he sustained when he fell from his bicycle); *cf. James M. McEnroe III*, 60 Van Natta 906 (2008) (record established that the claimant's head and neck injuries were a compensable consequential condition because he lost his balance and fell after a blow to the head, which would not have occurred if he had not suffered the initial compensable hip injury that negatively affected his balance and made him unable to endure the impact without falling over).

ORDER

The ALJ's order dated July 11, 2013 is affirmed.
