Claimant requested, and the insurer cross-requested, review of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Brown's order. Claimant has withdrawn his request for review. Consequently, claimant's request for review is dismissed.

However, because the insurer has not withdrawn its cross-request for review, we retain jurisdiction over this case. Consequently, this order shall be interim and eventually will be incorporated into a final appealable order.

In light of these circumstances, the insurer is now the appellant and claimant is the respondent. Accordingly, the briefing schedule has been revised as follows. The insurer's appellant's brief must be filed within 21 days from the date of this order. Claimant's respondent's brief must be filed within 21 days from the date of mailing of the insurer's appellant's brief. The insurer's reply brief must be filed within 14 days from the date of mailing of claimant's respondent's brief. Thereafter, we will proceed with our review.
