



Wildfire Risk Mapping

(Section 18, 24, 25)

- To identify our communities most at risk from catastrophic wildfire
- Directs resources to protect Oregonians
 - Defensible Space
 - Hardening of Homes
- \$25 Million Community Risk Reduction Fund
 - Administered by Oregon State Fire Marshal
- Federal: Community Wildfire Defense Grant Program
 - Up to \$10 Million per project

October
To
February

- ODF transfers all information learned from public engagement to OSU
- OSU to review mapping lessons learned and update map, including new models
- BCD & OSFM complete code development language
- All: Build Community Engagement & Education Strategy with Community Leadership

March
To
September

- ODF/OSU: Delivers Draft Map Publicly
- All: Implement Community Engagement & Education Strategy with Communities and the Public.
- OSU: Make any map adjustments identified from the 4 months of public engagement.
- ODF: Focus on wildfire during fire season

October
To
December

- ODF/OSU: Delivers a Final Map - October 1
- ODF: Sends out notifications and administers 60-day Appeals Process
- All: Complete Process by 2023
