

This Is To Notify You That The Legislative Assembly Has Enacted A Land Use Planning Statute That May Affect The Permissible Uses Of Properties In Your Jurisdiction.

On July 15, 2009 the Legislative Assembly enacted HB 3298. The Department of Land Conservation and Development has determined that enactment of HB 3298 may affect the permissible uses of your property and other properties in the affected zone and may change the value of your property.

A few words of explanation to landowners who get this notice:

House Bill 3298, designates the Metolius basin and an adjoining area to be the Metolius Area of Critical State Concern (Metolius ACSC) and approves an accompanying management plan submitted to it by the Land Conservation and Development Commission (LCDC). The legislature approved the management plan and directed the LCDC to adopt the plan, by rule, with specified changes.

What uses are prohibited in the Metolius Area of Critical State Concern management plan approved under HB 3298?

- Any new destination resort, as defined by Statewide Planning Goal 8 or ORS 197.435 to 197.467.
- Any new golf course.
- Certain new residential, commercial, industrial or new uses exceeding a stated number of dwelling units, or exceeding an average annual consumptive use of water, depending whether the land is in Area 1 or Area 2.

Where will these laws apply?

HB 3298 approves the designation of the Metolius Area of Critical State Concern, as recommended by LCDC. This area includes the Metolius drainage basin and an adjoining area (Areas 1 and 2 in the management plan), which are located in portions of Jefferson and Deschutes counties. The prohibition on new destination resorts applies to lands mapped by Jefferson and Deschutes counties as eligible for destination resorts in the Metolius Area of Critical State Concern. Other prohibitions apply in the Metolius Area of Critical State Concern generally.
