FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) On June 18, 2012, Parent filed a request for a due process hearing. On June 20, 2012, the Oregon Department of Education referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH").
- (2) On July 19, 2012, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") McGorrin held a Pre-Hearing Conference via telephone. Counsel for Parent, Mary Broadhurst, and counsel for the Hillsboro School District, Richard Cohn-Lee, attended. Counsel advised that they were pursuing mediation. ALJ McGorrin scheduled a further Pre-Hearing Conference for July 27, 2012. On July 27, 2012, the parties notified ALJ McGorrin that the matter was resolved, and that settlement documents were being finalized. On August 7, 2012, Ms. Broadhurst notified ALJ McGorrin that she was requesting a dismissal without prejudice, and would be seeking a dismissal with prejudice if the Hillsboro School District completed a new IEP for Student before September 5, 2012. On August 9, 2012, a further Pre-Hearing Conference was held. At that conference, ALJ McGorrin advised the parties that when the OAH issues a dismissal without prejudice, it loses jurisdiction over the matter and cannot subsequently issue a dismissal with prejudice. The parties stated that they understood, and agreed that the OAH would issue only a dismissal without prejudice.

ORDER

Parent's request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn and the case is dismissed without prejudice.
