FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On February 8, 2019, Kim Sherman, attorney at law, filed a Request for Due Process Hearing with the Oregon Department of Education (ODE). ODE subsequently referred the request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). The OAH assigned the case to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) C. Meerdink for hearing.
- 2. On March 4, 2019, ALJ Meerdink convened a prehearing conference (PHC), with attorney Elizabeth Polay representing the District, and Ms. Sherman representing the Parent. During the PHC, the parties agreed to extend the 45-day deadline to issue a final order in this case to September 13, 2019. The parties also agreed to briefing schedules and hearing dates totaling 16 days in May and June 2019.
- 3. On April 4, 2019, Ms. Sherman requested via email that a PHC be scheduled to address discovery issues. On April 16, 2019, ALJ Meerdink convened a PHC, at which Ms. Sherman represented the Parent, and attorney Kelly Noor represented the District. After discussing discovery issues, ALJ Meerdink confirmed that the parties were still scheduled to begin the hearing on May 14, 2019.
- 4. On April 23, 2019, Ms. Sherman emailed the OAH and stated that the parties had reached a mediated settlement agreement in the case.
- 5. On May 2, 2019, Ms. Sherman emailed a Motion to Dismiss to the OAH stating that the Parent and District had executed a mediated agreement in the case, which included the requirement that Parent dismiss the Request for Due Process Hearing with prejudice.
