2022 SUMMER LEARNING GRANTS FINAL REPORT COVER LETTER

In 2021, the legislature provided \$200 million to support summer credit earning and enrichment opportunities for students in grades K-12 across the state. This investment was a resounding success. In response, the legislature appropriated an additional \$150 million for summer learning programs in 2022. \$100 million of these funds were provided to school districts, public charter schools, and education service districts (ESDs) across the state. These grants, administered by the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) provided for academic supports for high school students and enrichment programs for K-8 students. The remaining \$50 million was provided to community-based organizations across the state through grants administered by the Oregon Association of Education Service Districts (OAESD).

The focus of these grant programs was to prioritize those student communities that were disproportionately impacted by the pandemic, including historically underserved communities and students experiencing disabilities. Grantees were encouraged to use these funds to reduce or remove barriers to student participation for these groups. These funds were designed to continue the equity work started in 2021 and continue to mitigate the impacts of the pandemic on those student communities most affected.

As part of K-8 Enrichment and High School Academic Support Grants administered by ODE, grantees were required to submit final reports summarizing the programs offered and complete expenditure data to demonstrate how the funds were spent. The results of these reports can be found in the 2022 Summer Learning Grants Final Report Data Spreadsheet and Final Report Data Summary Presentation. A summary of each of these documents is below. Final Report Data Spreadsheet

The <u>Final Report Data Spreadsheet</u> contains the detailed data as submitted by each grantee. The spreadsheet has several tabs, each displaying different data points. Descriptions of each tab in order are as follows:

- * Report Data Overview: Summarizes the program data collected in the final reports submitted by grantees for both the K-8 Enrichment and High School Academic Support Grants.
- ❖ **K8 Enrichment Report Data:** Shows the detailed program data as submitted by each grantee including data points such as number of students served by grade, number of programs offered by type, number and type of accommodations provided to students experiencing disabilities.

- **K8 Enrichment Program Data:** Lists information about each program offered by grantee including the type of program, length of program, and attendance rate.
- HS Academic Report Data: Shows the detailed data as submitted by each grantee including data points such as number of students served, credits offered, credits earned by subject, and type of accommodations provided to students experiencing disabilities.
- Demographic Data: Shows the percentage of students served that identified as each demographic for each grant, including the percentage of students in each demographic statewide for comparison.
- Special Education Data: Shows the number of students served that experience each type of disability for each grant, including the number of students that experience each type of disability statewide for comparison.
- **Expenditures Overview:** Summarizes the expenditures by category each grant
- **K8 Enrichment Expenditures:** Shows each grantee's total allocation and total funds spent by category.
- HS Academic Expenditures: Shows each grantee's total allocation and total funds spent by category.
